For socks as pictured use Henry's Attic Kona Superwash (8 oz/560 yds) dyed with these Kool-Aid ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ flavors: Ice Blue Raspberry Lemonade with Lemon-Lime sprinkled in the exhausted dye bath for the blue-green color; Cherry for the red color.

[100, 140] yards of DK weight superwash wool yarn in natural white
Size $3.5 \mathrm{~mm} / \mathrm{US} 4 \mathrm{ndls}$ or size required to obtain gauge of $\mathbf{6}^{1 / 2} \mathbf{~ s t s} / \mathbf{i n c h}$ over stockinette
Waste yarn
Unsweetened soft-drink mix (for dyeing)
