HeartStrings Pattern: H61 - 9276

Lace and Cables Scarf

Here is a nicely reversible scarf in a beautiful organically flowing design.

An easy trellis lace stitch combines with interwoven lattice of textured knit-purl spot cables that appear to be floating.

To add to the ethereal appeal of this pattern design, our model is made in a soft metallic-enhanced yarn plied with tiny glass seed beads.

Size Planned measurements are 7" by 56" after finishing with light blocking.

Width can be adjusted in increments of the 16-st multiple (approximately 2½").

Number of row repeats can be worked to length desired.

Skill Level Advanced beginner. Both charted and line-by-line written stitch instructions are provided in the pattern.

Yarn and Needles

Lace weight or light fingering weight yarn — 325 yards for planned measurements. If changing width and/or length, adjust amount of yarn needed accordingly.

Knitting needles — size US 5 (3.75 mm) suggested.

Cable needle.

Gauge 25 stitches per 4 inches over finger-blocked stitch pattern.

Lace Starlight Stole



Lace Starlight is a luscious stole knitted in an interesting and lovely dropped stitch lace pattern.

The radiating strands of yarn remind us of rays of starlight. For added starlight sparkle, our model is made in a soft metallic-enhanced yarn plied with tiny glass seed beads.

This self-edged stole is worked in one piece. So when it is done, it is done except for a simple blocking to open up the lace pattern.

If you are familiar with hairpin lace, you might have thought this stole was crocheted. But actually it is knitted!

Size Planned finished measurements are 16" by 72". Width can be adjusted in increments of the 15-st multiple (approximately 2½"). Number of row repeats can be worked to length desired.

Yarn and Needles

Lace weight or light fingering weight yarn — 690 yards for planned measurements. If changing width and/or length, adjust amount of yarn needed accordingly.

Knitting needles — size US 6 (4 mm) suggested.

Gauge 6 stitches and 7 rows per inch over lace stitch pattern.

Skill Level Intermediate. Both charted and line-by-line written stitch instructions are provided.

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HeartStrings Pattern: H60 - 9253

Put on the Glitz Shrug



This lusciously flowing shrug in delicate cabled lace speaks for itself. It is knitted cuff to cuff with no seams to sew.

Our model is appropriately made in a soft metallic-enhanced yarn plied with tiny glass seed beads to really "put on the glitz".

Sizing

Petite to Extra-Large
 Cuff edge to cuff edge (length of knitting) —

55 (58, 61, 64, 67)"

Center back distance (width of knitting) —

26¼ (28, 28, 29¾)"

Cuff circumference:

8 (8½, 8½, 9, 9)"

Skill Level Intermediate. Both charted and line-by-line written stitch instructions are provided.

Yarn and Needles

Lace weight or light fingering weight yarn — 725 (850, 925, 1000, 1075) yards. If changing planned measurements, adjust amount of yarn needed accordingly.

Straight or circular knitting needles for main body of shrug (knitted flat) — US 8 (5 mm) or size to achieve gauge. Also, double points or circulars in same size for transition from cuff to main body.

Your choice of double points or circular needles for knitting the cuffs circularly and for transition to flat knitting — US 3 (3.25 mm) or comparably smaller needle size to that for which you get gauge.

2 cable needles.

Gauge 21 stitches and 24 rows per 4 inches over cabled lace stitch pattern used in main body of shrug.
