# Simple Angles Sacks 

The classic great fitting ribbed sock with distinctive styling. Easy-to-knit left and right-angled patterned bands embellish ribbing on legs. Another little design feature is the subtle diamond pattern on the heel flap, easily produced with a minor variation in the common slip-stitch heel.

## Sizing

Adult medium

## Yarn and Needles

Fingering weight sock yarn (15-17 wraps per inch), approximately 400 yards
Size 0 or 1 us ( 2.0 or 2.5 mm ) double point needles, set of 5
Gauge: $\mathbf{8}$ stitches per inch over stockinette stitch
Skill Level: Intermediate knitter


## Abbreviations and Pattern Stitches

eor - end-of-round
k-knit
k2tog - knit 2 stitches together
LH - left hand
ndl(s) - needle(s)
p-purl
p2tog - purl 2 stitches together
rep - repeat(ing)
rep from * - repeat all instructions from the previous asterick
RH - right hand
rnd(s) - round(s)
RS - right side (the side of the knitted fabric worn to the outside)
sl - slip
sl 1 - slip 1 stitch as if to purl unless otherwise directed
sl 1 wyib - slip 1 stitch as if to purl while keeping yarn to back of work
sl 1 wyif - slip 1 stitch as if to purl while keeping yarn to front of work
SSK - slip 1 stitch as if to knit, and then slip another stitch as if to knit; insert left needle tip into the 2 slipped stitches from left to right and knit these 2 stitches together
st(s) - stitch(es)
WS - wrong side (the side of the knitted fabric worn to the inside)
wyib - with yarn in back of work
wyif - with yarn in front of work
yo - yarn over

Note: Instructions are written assuming you are knitting stitches off your left-hand needle point onto your righthand needle point. If you are working instead from right to left, please adjust instructions to agree with your direction of work.
Pattern Stitch for Angle 1 (rep of 4 sts and 11 rnds)
Rnd 1: * k2 yo, SSK, rep from * to eor.
Rnds 2, 4, 6, 8, 10: k.
Rnd 3: Before beginning rnd, shift 1 st from each RH ndl to the LH ndl. * SSK, k2, yo, rep from * to eor.
Rnd 5: * SSK, k2, yo, rep from * to eor.
Rnd 7: * yo, k2, k2tog, rep from * to eor.
Rnd 9: k2, k2tog, yo, rep from * to eor.
Rnd 11: k1, k2tog, yo, k1, rep from * to eor.
Pattern Stitch for Angle 2 (rep of 4 sts and 11 rnds)
Rnd 1: * k2, k2tog, yo, rep from * to eor.
Rnds $2,4,6,8,10$ : k.
Rnd 3: * k1, k2tog, yo, k1, rep from * to eor.
Rnd 5: * k2tog, yo, k2, rep from * to eor.
Rnd 7: * k1, yo, SSK, k1, rep from * to eor.
Rnd 9: * k2, yo, SSK, rep from * to eor.
Rnd 11: Before beginning rnd, shift 1 st from each RH ndl to the LH ndl. *SSK, k2, yo, rep from * to eor.
