Spiraling Diamonds Lace-edged Towel

A featured pattern in the Bits of Lace 2012 Series at the KnitHeartStrings.com membership site

Turn an ordinary towel into something extraordinary. Whether for yourself or a gift for someone else, your lace-edged towel will have a special place in the heart and home.



Finished Size Lace edging is 2¾" by 16" (7cm by 40.6cm) or as needed to fit the towel to which you will attach the lace

Materials

Approximately 45 yards (41m) size 10 crochet cotton or equivalently-sized durable thread that is machine washable and dryable

16" (40.6cm) wide towel or size desired

Gauge Approximately 7½ stitches and 10 rows per inch (2.5cm) over stitch pattern

Knitting Needles Size US 2½ (3mm) suggested

Notions Sewing needle; sewing thread to match towel color

Skill Level Intermediate

Skills Needed Knit, purl, yarn over, cast on, bind off

Stitch Instructions Charted and written

Construction A strip of lace edging is knitted flat in one piece, then hand-sewn to a towel
