Lace-edged Doily

Decorate a cloth doily with a dainty lace edging knitted of fine thread. This lace-edged showpiece doily will look amazing anywhere you want a little something to protect furniture while displaying your lace knitting at the same time.



Finished Size 11" (28 cm) diameter

Materials

Approx 65 yards (60 m) of fine lace thread such as 35/2 bleached linen (as shown in photo above), size 30 or 40 cotton crochet/tatting thread, or size 12 pearl cotton

8" (20.3 cm) round linen or cotton cloth doily, hem-stitched and pre-washed

Gauge Lace edging repeat of 20 sts by 12 rows is approx 1¾" by 7/8" (44 by 22 mm) blocked

Knitting Needles Size US 2/0 (1.75 mm) suggested

Notions

Steel crochet hook size US 6 or 7 (approx 1.75 mm)

Small amount of waste thread for provisional cast on

Small tapestry needle with an eye that is just large enough to accommodate your thread

Skill Level Intermediate

Skills Knit, purl, yarn over, provisional cast on, purl bind off, grafting, single crochet

Stitch Instructions Charted and written

Lace Construction A strip of edging is knitted flat, then invisibly seamed into a circle
